

We offer several different programs for Children and Youth:

Newborn - 5th Grade:

All children Infants through 5th Grade register and pick up child and parent nametags at the Kids Korner counter in the Front Lobby. The Nursery - 4 year old classrooms are located in the Lobby and upstairs in The Clubhouse. Children may register at any time on Sunday morning.

A Nursery is available for infants through 3 years old during the Traditional Service at 8:45am. If the child is 4 years old to 5th grade he/she will accompany their parents to the service and be dismissed to our Children's Programming that happens during the sermon. Parents pick their children up after the service is over at the Kids Korner Counter in the Front Lobby.

A Nursery is available for infants through 2 years old during the Contemporary Service at 11:00am. Children's Programming is available in the Clubhouse for 3 and 4 year olds. Kindergarten through 5th Grade children accompany their parents to the service and be dismissed to our Children's Programming that happens during the sermon. Parents pick their children up after the service is over in the sanctuary at their designated pick up.
